Voluntary Service Animal Registry

A “service animal” is a dog or other animal individually trained to provide assistance to an individual with a disability. Service animals include, but are not limited to, guide dogs for the blind, hearing dogs for the deaf/hard of hearing, and service animals for individuals with physical disabilities and seizure disorders. Service animals/service dogs are not considered “pets” and are explicitly permitted under state and federal civil rights laws.

The University will require documentation for a service animal consistent with the American with Disabilities Act.

Students with service animals are not required to register with the Disability Services Office (DSO). The DSO maintains a Voluntary Service Animal Registry to support students on campus who use service animals by informing appropriate facility staff of the animal’s presence, informing first responders, and to assist with situations in which the animal’s access is challenged by University community members.
